OPTION 2: Use a HOLDING TANK and PUMP-OUT STATION OPTION 3: Use a TEMPORARY STORAGE like a porta-potty

OPTION 1: Use a MARINE SANITATION DEVICE, or discharge 3 nautical miles from shore

How to manage your marine sewage:

There are restrictions against discharging marine sewage into the waters of British Columbia. Marine sewage pollution can harm the environment, marine life, and human health. It may result in closures to shellfish farms, beaches, and swimming areas. You cannot discharge untreated sewage in rivers or lakes, and any coastal water within 3 nautical miles from shore.
